RULES & REGULATIONS

In addition to the Rules & Regulations listed at the front of the schedule, the following will apply to all ring events.

The Chief Steward shall have the final say in all decisions regarding any event and entrance into events.

The Chief Steward has the ability to alter or remove any event within the 2010 Roma Show program.

Any competitor or persons associated displaying disruptive or offensive behavior at the discretion of the Chief Steward will be asked to leave the grounds immediately and excluded from participating in any further events.

1. No Stallion shall be allowed on the grounds without bar and bit and handler must be over 17 years of age.

Nominations

2. Pre-nominations must be received in the Roma Show office (in person or mail) before Fri 30th April 2010 and accompanied by payment, disclaimer and swabbing form.
3. Nominations will be by ticket system.
4. Tickets will be available from the Secretary's Office on the grounds from Thursday 6th May
5. Choose carefully **NO REFUND** given on pre-nomination or on the day nominations without a veterinary or medical certificate.
6. Only Pre-nominations attract Roma Show Membership discount.
7. A Ticket to the value of the entry fee (inc GST) must accompany each nomination for each event.
8. Entry to judging arena for any event will be solely by ticket handed to the steward.
9. In the event of competitors classes clashing only competitors with pre-nomination tickets will be able to request the rings to be held up

Marshalling

10. First call for competitors in any event will be five minutes exactly before the programme scheduled time (if any) for the event.
11. Interested competitors should assemble with their horses in the marshalling area just outside the gate entry to the judging arena in time to hear the first call for their event.

12. Second call for competitors in any event will be to signal entry to the judging arena and hand tickets to stewards.
13. On completion of Second Call and at the discretion of the Gate Steward, he will secure the gate and advise the Chief Steward that all interested competitors have now entered the arena and judging may commence. All horses are to exit via the gate on the race track, any other exit is to be at the discretion of the stewards only. This is in the interest of competitor's safety.
14. A '**Maiden**' is a Hack, Galloway or Pony that has never won a Blue Ribbon at any Agricultural Show (Ring 1&2).
A '**Novice**' Hack is a horse that has not won an Open Championship at an Agricultural Show or a first at a Royal in hack classes(Ring 1&2).

Hacks

15. The height of Hacks at the Roma Show shall be over 15 hands. All Hacks must be measured and be able to produce an official height certificate.

Galloway's

16. The height of Galloway's at the Roma Show shall be over 14 hands, up to and including 15 hands. (Any horse measuring exactly 14 hands is a Pony for this Show: any Horse measuring exactly 15 hands is a Galloway for this Show). Ladies Galloway and Ladies Hack must be ridden by Lady 17 years and over. Gents Galloway and Gents Hack must be ridden by Gent 17 years and over.

District Qualification

17. All persons and horse must reside, and upon proof thereof, for at least three calendar months prior to May 2010 in the Maranoa Regional Council, are eligible to compete in all District events.
18. Residents of fringe areas of the above Shires and Town not classified as district competitors for any other Show may, on written application to the Roma Show Society Inc. be approved as District competitors for the 2010 Roma Show. Any such approval must be produced on demand.
19. Any horse mounted or ridden by a judge for the duration of the Roma Show 2010, other than when the horse is competing in an event in an arena will be disqualified from further competition.

Led Classes

20. In all Led Breed Classes papers, proof of age, breeding, registration and membership MUST BE PRODUCED on demand by the Chief Steward or Steward in charge of the ring.
21. Any horse that is dual registered may compete in one or more classes as long as the horse is registered with that association.
22. **IF YOUR HORSE IS REGISTERED IT MUST COMPETE IN THE REGISTERED CLASS ONLY.**

Protests

23. In the event of a dispute, the Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies shall apply.
24. The Ring Master shall have the power to ban from competition any competitor whose behavior to a Judge and/or Steward is considered offensive by the Judge, Steward or Ring Master.
25. Persons must lodge protests with \$100 bond which will be forfeited if protest is turned down and refunded if protest upheld.

Age

26. If requested by Stewards, children must be able to produce proof of age in Classes with age barriers, by producing an original copy of a Birth Certificate.

Measuring

27. All horses are required to be measured by a Steward. When measuring, an allowance of one half of an inch is to be made for shoes. Where an exhibitor disagrees with the Official Measurer's height for a horse which has been measured with shoes on, he may, should he so desire have it re-measured without shoes.
28. **Times for measuring will be on display at the secretaries office**

Horse Stalls

29. HORSE STALL PAYMENT MUST BE MADE IN FULL BEFORE STABLES ALLOCATED. There are a limited number of stables, so get in early.
30. All stabling enquiries should be to Ray Waldron (H46222 263).
31. Competitors will be issued with a receipt. Upon arrival on the grounds, please check to find stable allocations on each stable row.
32. NO REFUND GIVEN without vet or medical certificate
33. A plan of the stables and names will be available near the loading ramp. No straw is allowed in the stables – bedding will be provided.

Swabbing

34. The Roma Show Society Inc. reserves the right to swab for those substances prohibited by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the Equestrian Federation of Australia.

Camping

35. All exhibitors who desire to live on the grounds must place their camp or caravan in the Caravan Parks on the NORTHERN SIDE of the grounds. This will be at a cost of \$22 for the duration of the Show. *Note: All vehicles, including floats, must be removed to the assigned area by 9.30 am each morning.* Any exhibitor refusing to abide by these instructions may be ejected from the grounds and disqualified from further participation in the Show. The Society notifies that it intends to enforce this rule strictly. Toilet and Shower facilities are provided and electricity is available.

Working Australian Stock Horses

36. Working ASH classes are to be ridden in a snaffle bit & workouts will be taken from the March 2006 ASH Pattern Book. Contact Steward for pattern copies if required
37. Competitors competing in Classes 13-15 & 28-30 must be current members of the ASH Society

Show & Working Hunter Classes (141-170)

The Show Hunter Ring is sponsored by the Australian Hunter Horse Association ("AHHA") Membership forms for the AHHA will be available at the Horse office on the day of the show or can be downloaded from the AHHA website. You do not have to be a member of the AHHA to compete (except classes 151,159 & 167)

38. Horses must either compete in the Hunter Ring or Open Hack or Pony Ring, they may not compete in both with the exception of classes 88-91, 112-125.
39. Classes 141-170 will be judged as per the guidelines as set out by the Aust Hunter Horse Assoc. Refer to the 'Guide to Working Hunter Classes' as set out on their website:- www.hunterhorses.com.au (Rules and Regulations tab) before entering this ring.
40. Stallions are eligible to compete (handler/rider must be over 17years)
41. Hunter Ponies over 13hh may be ridden by an adult
42. A '**Novice**' is a *Rider* that has never won a first place in a similar event in the Open Ring of a Hack, Breed or Agricultural Show
An '**Intermediate**' is a horse or rider that has not won a first, second or third in a similar event at any Royal.

Pony Club Points

Peter Corfe Memorial Trophy

1. This trophy shall be awarded to the Zone 20 Registered Pony Club member who gains the highest points on one nominated horse in ridden or led classes. Normal Pony Club rules apply ie. Points only count for the nominated horse when ridden or led by the nominated Pony Clubber. The horse shall be owned or leased by that Pony Clubber and be one normally ridden at Pony Club.
2. Points – First- 3 points Second - 2 points Third -1 point Champion -5 points Res. Champion -3 points. In the event of a tie the points will be awarded the same Eg First- both competitors will receive 3 points.
3. Each competitor will have a card obtainable from the secretary's office. Competitor's points for an event become invalid if the child leaves the ring before getting the card signed by the chief steward of the appropriate ring. At the end of the third day the card will be taken by the Pony Club Member to the secretary's office.
4. Points from Friday Ring 3 events are not eligible for the Peter Corfe Memorial Trophy.

Hi Point Welsh/PB Welsh Award
